
Using Google Docs on a Tablet / Mobile


If you're having trouble editing your documents in Google Slides, Sheets or Docs and you're using a mobile or tablet then please make sure to download those three apps from either the Play Store (Android) or the App Store (Apple - iPhone or iPad)

To do this:


-click on the Play Store or App Store (depending on which device you have)




-search for Google Slides



-click to install it




-the apps will now be on your home screens




- -when you open an assignment from Google Classroom make sure to open it in the App (it should do this automatically or it will ask you)
- -when you open the work you have to click the 'edit' icon at the bottom left to make changes to the work. It will save automatically.


After this you have to Turn In the work. To do this:

- -go back to the classroom
- -find the assignment you have just worked on and click on it
- -you will be presented with the following screen



- -on this screen click on 'View Assignment'
- -You will be presented with the following screen





-you can see a big button saying 'Turn In'. click it and you have handed your work in.

Follow the above procedure for Google Docs, Slides and Sheets.
