Safeguarding Update: out-of-school settings. Many of our children take part in a range of enriching activities outside of school with external providers. This includes sports clubs, places of worship, community groups in additional to tuition and coaching sessions.

Recent safeguarding reviews have highlighted the importance of parents feeling confident that their child is safe within these settings. The DfE parental guidance on Keeping Children Safe during Community Activities, After-school Clubs and Tuition equips parents with the appropriate ques-

tions that you may wish to ask providers to ensure your child's safety during whilst they are not in vour care.

Primary school admissions. The online admissions portal for primary schools is now open and will close on 15 January 2023. If your child's date of birth falls between 01/09/2018 31/08/2019, you will need to apply for a reception place for September 2022. Allocations day is 19 April 2023.
